Accepted Materials

Paper & Cardboard

Books, Newspapers, and Magazines

Remove hardcovers and recycle book pages

Milk and Juice Cartons

Must be clean.

Office Paper, Envelopes, Mail

Paper must not have metal bindings.

Telephone Books

Place with mixed paper.

Brown Boxes and Paper Bags

Must be clean.

Cereal and Product Boxes

Place with mixed paper.

Corrugated Cardboard

Must flatten; pieces smaller than 3 ft by 3 ft.

Clean Pizza Boxes

No grease or food residue.

Plastic & Metal

Plastics #1 to #7

Must have recycling symbol; must be clean.

Plastic Films

Plastic bags, plastic film, bubble wrap.

Aluminum Cans, Foil, Pie Tins

Clean only.

Deposit Bottles and Cans (CT 10¢)

Must be marked for CT deposit.

Scrap Metal

All kinds.

Small Propane & Butane Gas Tanks

Empty tanks less than 20 lb.

Glass

Clean bottles and jars; separate by color; no caps, lids, or corks. No blue glass or window glass.

Special Items

Light Bulbs (Fluorescent, CFL, LED)

Place in designated area.

Electronic Waste (E-waste)

Visit www.take2recycle.com for complete list.

Motor Oil

Uncontaminated only; must be tested by attendant.

Automotive Antifreeze

Must not be contaminated.

Batteries (All Types)

Auto batteries may be traded in for core credit.

Appliances

\$10.00 fee for appliances with refrigerant.

Tires

With or without rims.

Cooking Oil

Used Textiles

Used clothes, shoes & other textiles.

Mattresses and Box Springs

Recyclable if dry and clean, with no major stains; no bedbugs; \$25.00 fee if not recyclable.

Bulky Waste

By appointment only. Call (203) 393-1555 to make an appointment. Visit bethanyct.gov/bulkywaste
